Objective: To socialize the study guides designed for students and parents for practicing elementary English outside the classroom.

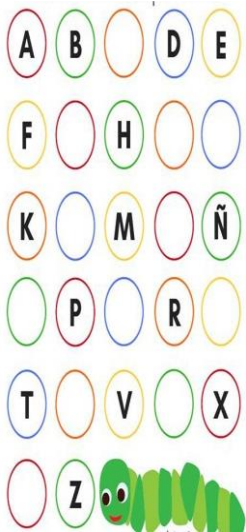
Tips for parents:

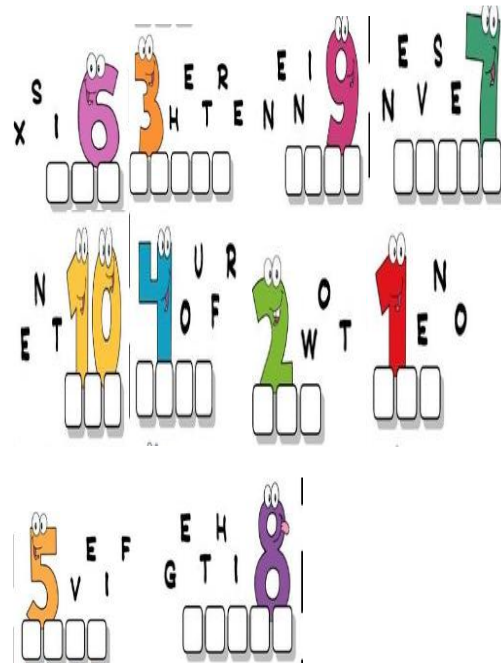
Missing letters

Help the worm to find the missing letters.



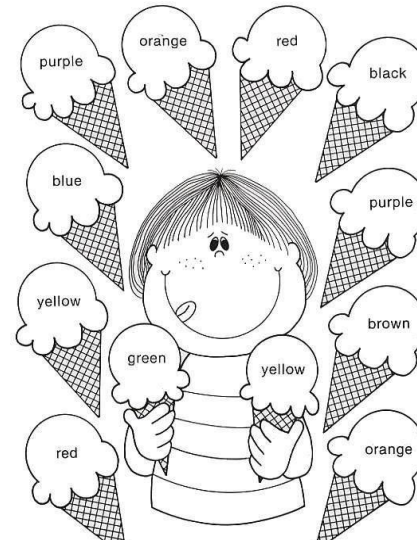
Unscrambled numbers
